A bare-bones checklist of action items to help you maximise your potential to earn points on credit card (CC) or loyalty program (LP). Allocate your credit card spending based on earnings type Sign up for the loyalty programs at the 3 stores where you spend the most money Sign up for your preferred airline loyalty program Sign up for your preferred hotel loyalty program Sign up for your loyalty program newsletters Sign up for your credit card newsletters Set monthly reminders to pay your credit card the day it's due. Set an annual reminder to review new travel credit cards



STEP 7: SET YOUR POINTS GOALS

Scenario 1: You don't have your credit card yet - but you will soon! Refer to the worksheets for Steps 4/5 above to roughly calculate how many points you'll need for your trip.

Scenario 2: You have been approved for your new credit card - congrats! Look up the app for your credit card. It should have a points calculator built in!
